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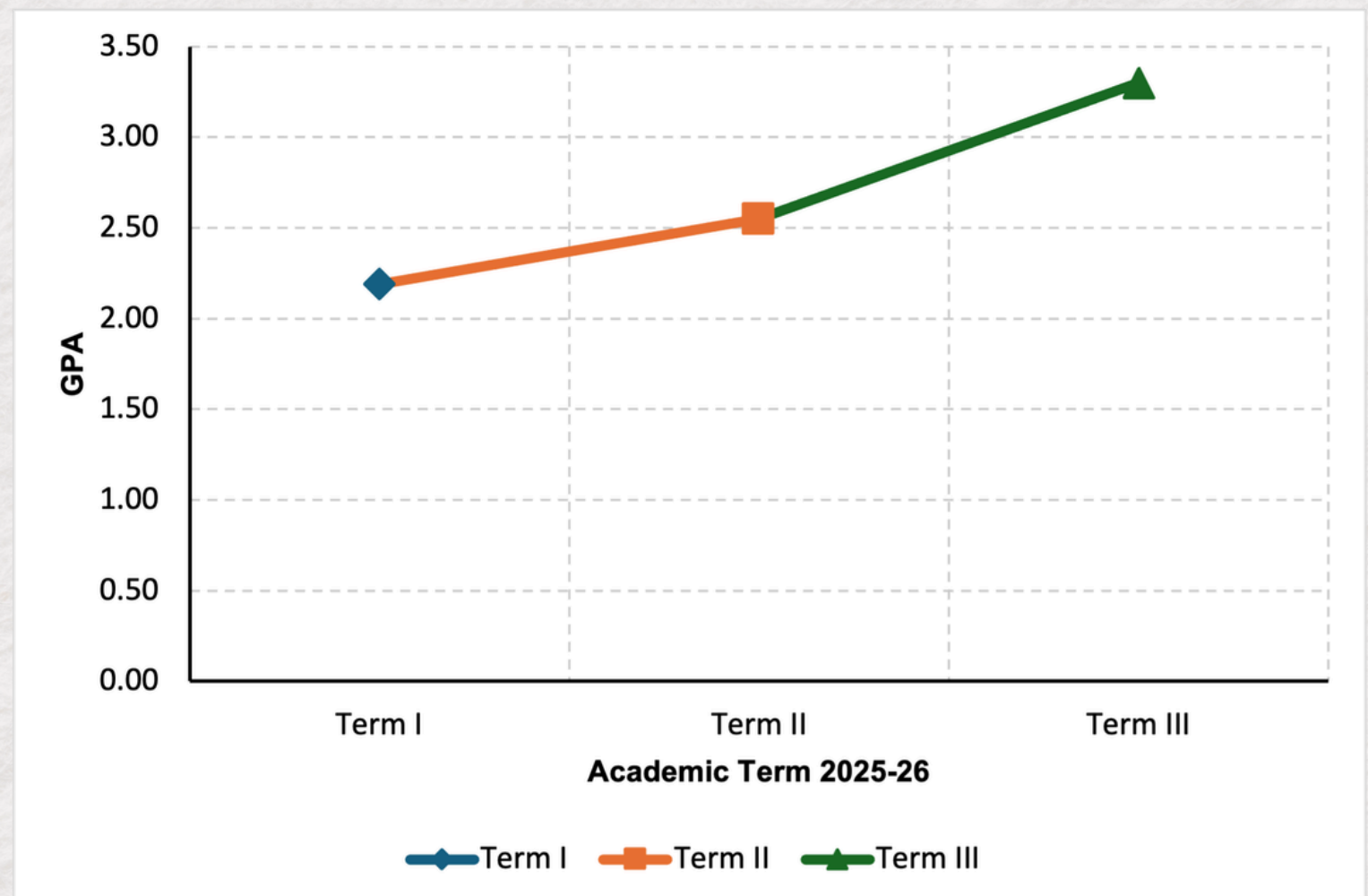
ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE IMPROVED AT UTE

*We are proud to congratulate our students on the fact that their average GPA score improved from term to term. The University of Technology and Entrepreneurship (UTE) has recorded a strong improvement in academic performance among Cohort I students, showing positive progress across three academic terms. Based on their scores, Cohort I students achieved an average GPA of **2.19 in Term I**, followed by a significant increase to **2.55 in Term II**, before making a jump to **3.30 in Term III**.*

This improvement reflects the continuous effort of students, faculty members, and the academic support team in strengthening the quality of learning at UTE. While the progress from Term I to Term II was modest, the sharp increase in Term III demonstrates that students became more confident, better prepared, and more capable of meeting academic expectations as they advanced through their studies.

*The GPA growth from **2.55 to 3.30** represents an overall increase of **0.75 points**, which is a meaningful achievement for the first cohort. It suggests that students are adapting well to UTE's academic environment, learning systems, teaching methods, and assessment standards. The result also highlights the importance of consistent academic monitoring, faculty guidance, and student engagement throughout the term.*

UTE views this improvement not only as a rise in GPA, but also as evidence of stronger learning habits, better academic discipline, and growing student confidence. As the university continues to develop its academic systems and student support services, UTE remains committed to helping students achieve stronger academic outcomes and prepare for future professional success.



UTE WITH EUROPEAN GLOBAL MOBILITY AND JOINT DEGREES

UTE is expanding its international academic vision through opportunities related to European global mobility and joint degree development. This initiative reflects UTE’s ambition to connect Cambodian higher education with international standards, global learning experiences, and cross-border academic collaboration.

On 08 May 2026, UTE signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the World Learning Group's School of Business and Management (SBM), spanning its campuses in Malta and Istanbul. This landmark agreement establishes a robust framework for academic exchange and student mobility, anchored by a clear system for mutual credit recognition and seamless transferability. Most notably, the partnership introduces an innovative "3+1" joint program. Under this structure, UTE students can complete three years of foundational and specialized coursework on our campus before spending their final year at one of SBM's European or transcontinental campuses. This initiative provides our student body with invaluable global exposure and dual-institutional perspective, sharpening their competitive edge in the international job market.

Global mobility provides students and faculty with opportunities to experience learning and teaching in different cultural and academic environments. Through potential partnerships with European institutions, UTE aims to create pathways for student exchange, faculty exchange, research collaboration, and international academic exposure. These opportunities will help students broaden their perspectives and prepare for careers in an increasingly globalized world.

The development of joint degrees is also an important step toward strengthening UTE's academic profile. Joint degree programs can allow students to benefit from the expertise of both UTE and international partner universities. Such programs may include shared curriculum design, co-teaching, international quality assurance, and recognition from partner institutions. This will create stronger academic value and increase the competitiveness of UTE graduates.

For UTE, internationalization is not simply about sending students abroad. It is about bringing global quality into the local learning environment. By working with European partners, UTE seeks to enhance curriculum quality, introduce new teaching practices, strengthen research capacity, and build a more internationally connected academic community in Cambodia.



MOU WITH BIOMEDIC DIAGNOSTIC CENTER



UTE has taken another important step in building industry partnerships through the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding with Biomedic Diagnostic Center. This collaboration demonstrates UTE's commitment to connecting education with professional practice, especially in fields related to health science, laboratory work, diagnostics, technology, and applied learning.

Through this partnership, UTE students, staff, and parents may benefit from a certain percent discount from BDC, and students may have the opportunity to be exposed to real workplace environments, industry knowledge, professional standards, and hands-on learning opportunities. The partnership with Biomedic Diagnostic Center also creates opportunities for faculty and professionals to exchange knowledge and explore areas of mutual interest. By working closely with industry experts, UTE can continue to improve its curriculum and ensure that students are learning skills that are relevant to current market needs. This MOU reflects UTE's broader strategy of building strong links between university education and the world of work. UTE believes that meaningful partnerships with companies, organizations, and professional institutions are essential for producing graduates who are capable, confident, and ready to contribute to Cambodia's development.

UTE AND TALENT CULTIVATION AT BATTAMBANG

We continue to support talent cultivation beyond Phnom Penh, including important engagement in Battambang. This reflects the university's mission to create wider educational opportunities and to identify, encourage, and develop young talent across Cambodia.



UTE conducted an impactful on-site workshop on university preparation and major counseling for 12th graders at Kdol Don Teav High School in Battambang on 28 May 2026.

Battambang is one of Cambodia's important provinces with strong potential in education, entrepreneurship, creativity, and youth development. By engaging with students, schools, communities, and local partners in Battambang, UTE aims to inspire young people to pursue higher education, technology, innovation, and entrepreneurial thinking.

Talent cultivation is not only about academic achievement. It is also about helping young people discover their strengths, build confidence, develop leadership skills, and understand future career pathways. UTE's activities in Battambang can include orientation sessions, academic sharing, workshops, competitions, career guidance, and outreach programs that encourage students to think about their future with ambition and purpose.

EXHIBITION AT PREK LEAP HIGH SCHOOL (NGS)

UTE participated in the high-profile Annual Student Achievement Exhibition at Prek Leap High School, a recognized New Generation School (NGS). The event served as an important platform for UTE to engage directly with a strong group of Grade 12 students, many of whom are preparing for national examinations and beginning to make important decisions about their future university studies. UTE team was able to make the process clearer, more accessible, and less stressful for prospective students and their families.

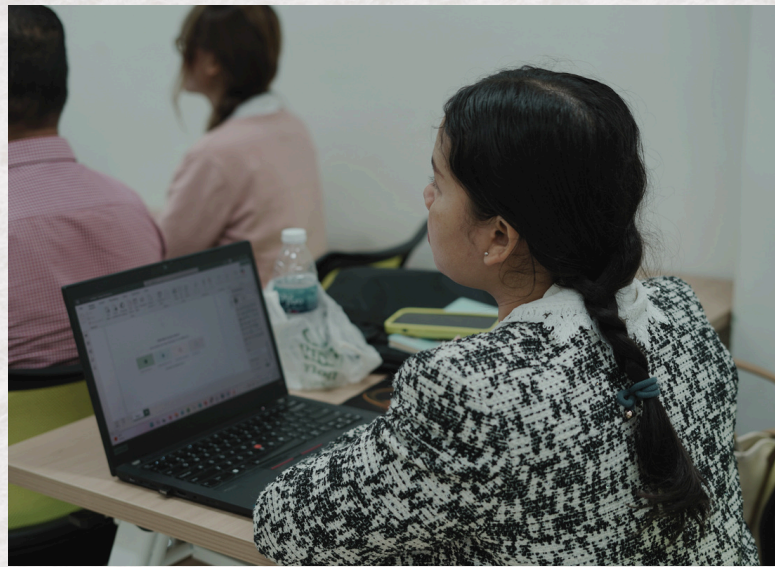
